- are* – shows certainty – 'we are
good'

- weather* – sun, rain, snow
- whether* – starts to joins two parts of a
sentence.

I will enjoy the day, **whether** the **weather**
is nice or not.

accept – except

- accept* – to believe or agree
– to take something
- except* – not including

I would **accept** your invitation **except** I'm
busy that day.

which – witch

- which* – specifying something or referring to something previously
mentioned.
- witch* – a fictional woman on a broomstick.
