English Language GCSE

Students follow a one-year course leading to the AQA English Language GCSE.

This involves reading and responding to a variety of text types, including fiction and non-fiction and writing in a number of different styles appropriate to purpose and audience.

The GCSE English Language course is linear and consists of 2 exams.

The exams (total 100%):

- Paper 1: Explorations in creative reading and writing**
Section A – responding to a literature fiction text
Section B – descriptive or narrative writing
- Paper 2: Writers' viewpoints and perspectives**
Section A – responding to one non-fiction and one literary non-fiction text
Section B – writing to present a viewpoint
